2004-05 Chevy Colorado Bumper Grille

Step 1: Center billet grille in opening.

Step 2: Drill (4)-3/32" holes thru tab into bumper cover. Then attach the billet grille by using the supplied #8 screws in the holes just drilled. See Fig.A

Step 3: If you live in a State that requires the use of a front license Plate, please continue with installation. Remove the license plate holder by removing the (2) Rivets shown below (Fig. B).

Step 4: Next you will need to trim the license plate holder by using a cut-off wheel or saw. Measure 1 1/8" from the backside of the holder as shown in (Fig. C) place a piece of masking tape to use as a guide when cutting. Then cut holder as shown below in (Fig. D). File edge smooth, then re-install the lincense plate holder to the vehicle.
